As part of the registration process you are required to complete the online registration form through the Skyward portal, which will open on Monday, March 28, 2022. Once your form is completed, you will be required to provide 5 proofs of residency (no more than 30 days old) at one of the dates below.

Registration requirements for Berwyn North School District 98 include the following:

- _____ Reside in the Berwyn North District 98 school district.
- _____ For Kindergarten, your child must be five years old on or before September 1, 2022.
- _____ Show five (5) proofs of residency (no more than 30 days old). **For Pre-K students, proof of income is required.**
- _____ Original birth certificate required for all new students. (Not a baptismal or hospital certificate.)
- _____ Kindergarten, 6th grade, and All New Transfer Students need a current physical examination with immunization information at registration.
- _____ Kindergarten, 2nd and 6th grade, a dental examination must be in by May 15, 2023.
- _____ Kindergarten, a vision examination must be in by October 15, 2022.
- _____ **School fees are due at time of registration. Fees for Grades K-8 are \$48 and \$25 Chromebook fee. (Only Cash) There is an additional fee for the required gym uniform and other supplies for students attending Lincoln Middle School.**
- _____ Please refer to the [school boundaries page](#) for your assigned neighborhood school. All children will attend their neighborhood schools.
- _____ School Dress Code - Blue Polo, Blue Pants/Shorts/Skirts, and joggers (no skin tight pants, denim, nor leggings)
- _____ Transfer Students: Transfer Form from Previous School is required at Registration.
